

Position in Mathematics Education

The Department of Mathematics and Statistics seeks to hire a tenure-track assistant or associate professor with a specialization in mathematics education. The successful candidate is expected to have a strong record of, or potential for, research necessary to support a doctoral program in mathematics education. The candidate must have the equivalent of a master's degree in mathematics and hold a doctorate in mathematics education. Excellence in research, teaching, and service is expected. Public school teaching experience is desirable. Review of applicants will begin November 30th and continue until the position is filled.

Sam Houston State University is located in historic Huntsville, 60 miles north of Houston in the Piney Woods region of East Texas. The university has a student enrollment of approximately 16,400 and a faculty of 650. The Mathematics and Statistics Department has 26 tenured faculty positions in mathematics, mathematics education, and statistics. We seek to have someone join a highly collegial and professionally active cohort of 8 mathematics educators in the Department. The BA, BS, MA, & MS degrees are offered in Mathematics. The MEd degree is also offered through the College of Education for middle school teachers with a minor in mathematics.
