The Department of Mathematics and Statistics at Sam Houston State University anticipates filling one or more tenure-track positions in Mathematics, at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor, pending funding. Candidates should have a PhD in Mathematics, excellent communication skills, and a strong commitment to quality teaching, research, and academic service. Preference will be given to candidates whose research interests complement those of current faculty; however, all qualified candidates are encouraged to apply.

One of the fastest growing universities in Texas, Sam Houston State University is located in historic Huntsville, 60 miles north of Houston in the Piney Woods region of East Texas. The university has an enrollment of approximately 16,400 and 650 faculty. The Department of Mathematics and Statistics has 26 tenured or tenure track faculty positions in mathematics, mathematics education, and statistics. The BA, BS, MA, & MS degrees are offered in Mathematics. A PhD in Mathematics Education is currently at the approval stage at the state level.
