Courses Offered - ECON 4360 & ECON 4085

In these courses we will develop an understanding of current German business practices and culture, and cover the principle of Social Market Economics and its role in the economic development of Germany since World War II.

Financial information:

- 1. Program fee of \$1,900 (includes housing accommodation, most breakfast and lunch meals, field trips, special activities, guest lectures)
- 2. Airfare (~\$1,000-\$1,700 for a round-trip flight)
- 3. Tuition for 6 hours.
- 4. Food and any other personal expenses

<u>Scholarships:</u>

- 1. The College of Business Administration (COBA) will give a scholarship of at least \$1,000 for business majors with a GPA of 3.0 or higher.

We will stay at a hostel that is conveniently located next to the main train station in Aachen. These accommodations are included in the program fee. The hostel includes breakfast.

Aachen is very well connected to other major European cities. Last year, we visited the EU facilities in Brussels, took a 2-day trip to Paris, and students visited Amsterdam on a free day.
