Here are some options to involve you in helping your child at home:

Spring Picture Day

<u>Math</u>

Pictures will be right away in the morning.

Kinder: Shapes names and designs 1st: Shapes, sides, and designs

If your child is wearing picture only clothes, make sure to pack an extra pair to change into.

Science:

Earth & Space features. Discuss what we see in the day time (weather, seasons,) and what we would see at night time (planets, stars, satellites)



Social Studies: Land formations Talk about the different kinds of land forms and where we would locate them:

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volcanoes, mountains, hills, lakes, ponds, plains, rivers, ocean, beach, valleys, etc

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Homework Space

Using a quiet place helps lessen distractions and reinforces working on a task for a certain amount of time.

If possible create a homework corner or space to help your child get in the routine of doing homework and utilizing a quiet space.

Try to help your child not to fidget as much by testing their ability to stay on a task for a time. This

Making Mistakes

Learning to make mistakes is a tough thing to do. Practicing helps build your student's skills and confidence to try and fail. Making a mistake can be hard to deal with, so practice making mistakes and trying again to boost confidence and lessen frustrations.
