Talk about the different kinds of
land forms and where we would
locate them:

Homework Space

Using a quiet place helps lessen distractions and reinforces working on a task for a certain amount of time.

If possible create a homework corner or space to help your child get in the routine of doing homework and utilizing a quiet space. Try to help your child not to fidget as much by testing their ability to stay on a task for a time. This will help with focus.



Making Mistakes

Learning to make mistakes is a tough thing to do. Practicing helps build your student's skills and confidence to try and fail. Making a mistake can be hard to deal with, so practice making mistakes and trying again to boost confidence and lessen frustrations.
