Follow these instructions to complete the two assessments

Quick Tip! Mark one (1) answer for every question. Remember, don't over think your responses. The MBTI Career Report suggests what careers match your personality.

The Strong Interest Inventory helps you choose a major and possible career that best fits your interests.

Start by first going to online.cpp.com

Log-in using the username: **bearkat (all lowercase)** and the password: **careerpath14 (all lowercase)**

Choose either MBTI[®] Step I (Form M) or Newly Revised Strong Interest Inventory and click the "Begin" button. *You will need to return to this area of the website after completion of the first assessment to begin the second following the same steps.

Under "Assessment Information" select your Orientation Session "[Summer Orientation 1-8]" from the drop-down "Batch Name" menu. This is important to help us locate your report quickly! Once you do this, fill out the required background information and begin!

Click "Submit" when finished. You will be given an ID number - **be sure to write it down** in case you need to log out before taking your second assessment. (The ID lets you to log back in where you left off and not have to restart.)

Remember!

There are no right or wrong answers, choose what feels natural - not what you feel qualified to do. This isn't a skills test!

Once you complete both assessments, they will be sent to a Career Services Counselor. **To receive your results at orientation**, you must have completed the assessments *two (2) days prior* to your session.

Your results will be available at the MBTI/SII Group Career Assessment Interpretation Sessions located in the CHSS, Rm. 70 the first day of orientation at 10-10:45 a.m. or 10:45-11:30a.m. You can then use these results when getting advised!
