I look forward to seeing you around our college and at these undergraduate events — have a wonderful semester people.





Have You Filed a Degree Plan?

Why file a degree plan?

• Only by filing a degree plan can you officially declare Criminal Justice as your major.

How to file a degree plan?

- Fill out a degree plan in the CJ Advisement Center, Room A214.
- ◆ Your declaration must be signed before it is processed by the Registrar's Office.

An official degree plan application will not be processed if a student:

- Is currently on academic probation or suspension.
- ♦ Is not currently enrolled at SHSU.
- Has not completed 30 semester credit hours.
- Has coursework from transfer institutions that has not been placed on the student's SHSU transcript.
