Master of Business Administration Program (BADM) [36 hours]

Core Courses (required): all are 3-hour courses; total of 24 hours)

- ACCT 5304 Accounting for Management
- BUAD 5310 Research Writing in Business
- BANA 5368 Techniques of Statistical Analysis
- MKTG 5330 Marketing Management
- FINC 5310 Introduction to Institutions, Investments, and Managerial Finance
- ECON 5XXX (any 5000 level ECON course, excluding ECON 5380)
- MGMT 5XXX (any 5000 level MGMT course, excluding MGMT 5380 and MGMT 5390)
- MGMT 5390 Seminar in Strategic Management and Policy

General Electives: may select any **four** 3-hour COBA graduate course for which all prerequisites are met 3-hour courses, for a total of 12 hours, excluding any 5300 course

Stem Requirements for Non-Business Graduates

Students seeking admission to the MBA Program who **do not** have a baccalaureate degree in business from a U.S. institution or from an Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB, International) accredited university will be required to complete the following course requirements as prerequisites to graduate business courses.

BANA 5300	Quantitative Tools for Business (or both BANA 2372 and MGMT 4370)
BUAD 2301	Business Legal Environment (or BUAD 3355)
ECON 5300	Economic Principles and Policy (or both ECON 2302 and ECON 2301)
FINC 3320	Business Finance
MGMT 3310	Principles of Management
MGIS 3310	Management Information Systems
MKTG 3310	Principles of Marketing

Army CGSC Admissions

To be considered for admission, applicants must submit:

1. Graduate Studies Application
2. Application fee
3. Official transcript from the baccalaureate degree granting institution (To qualify under the Army CGSC program, the applicant must have an undergraduate GPA from the degree granting institution of 3.0 or higher.)
4. Current resume or vita
5. CGSC transcript (proof of enrollment in the ILE Common Core or completion of the Common Core Curriculum)

Officers will be required to submit an official transcript upon completion of CGSC if enrolled in the MBA program before credit hours will be granted. Upon successful completion of the Army Command and General Staff College Common Core Curriculum, officers will receive nine hours of management credit toward the MBA degree program, specifically:

- MGMT 5315 - Seminar in Operations Management
- MGMT 5330 - Operations Planning and Control
- MGMT 5345 - Seminar in Team Leadership
