Admission Requirements

Prior to beginning your education coursework you must meet the following requirements:

- Have a 2.75 overall GPA and a 2.75 GPA in your major. This includes all transfer and SHSU courses.
- Have a "C" or better in all coursework.
- Take a Basic Skills test (See back page).
 - Report scores to Undergraduate Admissions

Beginning Coursework

When you begin your education coursework you must meet the following requirements:

- When enrolled in beginning coursework (SPED 2301, CIEE 2333, CIEE 3374, CISE 3384) you must make an application to Education Preparation Services and pay the \$100.00 fee.
- You must create a TK20 account and pay the \$112.00 fee.
- Admission Video Interview (Instruction will be given in your coursework)
- Maintain a 2.75 GPA.
- Maintain a "C" or better in all coursework.

**** THE BELOW CRITERIA IS REQUIRED AS OF January 1, 2015**

The Texas State Board for Educator Certification requires that basic skills scores in reading, written communication, and mathematics must be achieved from one of the following tests or a combination thereof.

I. THEA

- a. Reading Scores: 250
- b. Writing Score: 240
- c. Math Score: 230

II. ACCUPLACER

- a. Reading Score: 83
- b. Written Score: 6 (or 5 with a writing skills score of 80)
- c. Math Score: 63

III. ASSET

- a. Reading Score: 44
- b. Written Score: 6 (or 5 with a writing skills score of 40)
- c. Math Score: 38

IV. COMPASS

- a. Reading Score: 84
- b. Written Score: 6 (or 5 with a writing skills score of 40)
- c. Math Score: 39

OR:

V. SAT

- a. 1500 out of 2400 (Verbal+Math+Writing)

VI. ACT

- a. 18 English, 21 Reading, 22 Mathematics

OR:

VII. Writing

- a. B or better in ENGL 1301 or 1302

VIII. Math

- a. B or better in MATH 1385 or B or better in MATH 1314

IX. Reading

- a. No substitute

How to View Your Basic Skills Assessment Scores

- Login to MySam on shsu.edu
- Select the "Students" tab
 - Go the section titled "Banner Self-Service"
 - Select the "Banner Self Service" folder
 - Select the "Student" folder
 - Select the "View Test Scores" document

After selecting "View Test Scores" you will be taken to a page containing all tests available, including score and test date details.
