Thank you for your interest in the 2013 SHSU STEM Summer Camp hosted by Sam Houston State University. Attached, you will find all application materials and consent forms necessary to apply for the camp. The SHSU Summer STEM Camp will provide students with the opportunity to take part in hands-on activities, experiments, and field experiences related to animal science, plant science, aerospace engineering, renewable energy, and much more. This camp is for female high school students entering grades 9-12 in the fall of 2013. The camp promotes science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) education and supports historically underserved and underrepresented students with limited opportunities. Students selected to attend the camp will do so *free of charge* due to the generosity of the Texas Workforce Commission.

The SHSU STEM Camp is a 5-day, educational, residential camp with the goal of increasing students' knowledge and skills in the STEM areas while introducing them to college life and stimulating their interest in science and engineering as a potential career path. Each day, campers will participate in activities led by university faculty that include problem solving, research, critical thinking, and communication skills incorporated with biology, chemistry, physics, environmental sciences, engineering, technology, and design concepts.

The camp will be hosted by the Department of Agricultural and Industrial Sciences and will be held on the campus of Sam Houston State University, Huntsville, Texas. Students will be housed in a secure dormitory on the university's campus and all meals will be provided by an on-campus dining facility. Registration for the camp will remain open until the camp is full; however, this camp is limited to 30 participants, so please submit your application as soon as possible. Applications will not be considered until all requested documents are received.

Application Process:

- Parent/Guardian and student complete the attached student application forms and consent forms
- Parent/Guardian or student gives the request for records to the student's school registrar
- Parent/Guardian or student gives a recommendation form to the student's current science teacher

Please read the following and sign below:

The purpose of the 2013 SHSU STEM Summer Camp is to increase the quality, quantity, and diversity of students pursuing and obtaining degrees in science, technology, engineering and mathematics. The summer camp will last for five days. This camp is sponsored through a grant by the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) which requires that we gather some data about student participants' demographics, camp experiences, and career goals to demonstrate that TWC objectives are met.

Camp applications will be reviewed by a committee and students will be selected to participate. Submission of an application does not ensure that a student will be selected to participate. If I agree to participate in this camp, I understand that I may be interviewed, and I agree to participate in focus groups, respond to surveys, and be included in photographs for documentation and publicity purposes (no names will be used). If I enroll or transfer to Sam Houston State University (SHSU), I will allow the project management to follow my progress through the completion of my degree program at SHSU.

There will be minimal to no risk associated with camp participation. The benefits of participation include the opportunity to learn more about STEM disciplines and to interact with university faculty that are experts in the various disciplines. Final camp reports will be submitted to TWC. All of the data gathered during this camp is confidential. No identifiers linking me to the study will be included in any sort of report that might evolve. Camp activity records will be stored securely and will not be shared with anyone other than the TWC grant's management team and evaluators.
