

The *Journal of Finnish Studies* acknowledges the importance of open access to knowledge. Starting from the 2012 issues, all *Journal of Finnish Studies* articles are available electronically (database: Humanities Source Publications) through subscribing libraries.

The *Journal of Finnish Studies* adheres to delayed self-archiving of the published version of the article (Sherpa/Romeo Green) in academic and institutional repositories, with a 12-month delay starting from the month of publication. After thirty-six months, the articles will also be made available in pdf-form on the *Journal of Finnish Studies* website. All authors are encouraged to publish the abstracts of their *JoFS* pieces, together with reference to the *JoFS* issue where the articles appeared. This should be done immediately after the articles themselves have been published.

Traditional subscription makes it possible for the *Journal of Finnish Studies* to continue publishing serious academic research on Finland and the Finnish diaspora in English for a global audience.
