During the academic year, students participate in activities that support and encourage a high level of educational achievement. In addition, the program will also offer a series of workshops ("How to succeed in Graduate School") as well as other cultural and educational activities. The academic year activities are specifically designed to prepare students to be candidates for the next summer's research component.
