

SHSU 2009 ACADEMIC CHALLENGE STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

NEW LOCATION: CHSS Building

Below is the schedule for the April 18th Academic Challenge. We have 10 teams competing this year. Each team will play 5 matches before the seeded rounds. The top 8 teams will move on to compete in the seeded matches. These teams will be seeded based on win/loss record. Ties will be broken by point totals. If ties still exist, a coin will be tossed.

This year, the competition will be held in a new location: the CHSS Building (College of Humanities and Social Sciences). The CHSS Building is located near the Johnson Coliseum on 20th Street/Bowers Blvd. Academic Challenge Central will be located in CHSS 430. Complimentary refreshments will be available in CHSS 400. All matches will be held on the 2nd floor of the CHSS.

The first match begins promptly at 8:40. Your team should be checked in by 8:20 at the latest. Teams more than 5 minutes late to a match will forfeit.

Lunch will be served from 11:50 to 12:50 in the Lowman Student Center in the Paw Print. This is the area located on the bottom floor. The entrance is on the east side of the Lowman Student Center.
