

Valedictorian Scholarship

The State of Texas gives this scholarship to the highest graduating senior in his/her class at any state supported high school in Texas. It waives tuition and designated tuition only for 2 semesters. The student may use the scholarship for any 2 of the first 4 regular semesters following the student's graduation from high school, or when, in the opinion of the institution's president, the circumstances of an individual case merit the action. The student is to bring a certificate, received from their high school counselor, naming him/her valedictorian of their specific high school to the Business Office. Once we receive this certificate from the student and the student has registered for the first semester they want to use their waiver, **it is the student's responsibility to let the Business Office know that he or she is registered and the scholarship needs to be applied to his or her student account. This same rule applies when they register for the second semester that they want to use the scholarship. The scholarship will not be automatically applied to the student's account at anytime.**

Requirements:

- Be named the valedictorian of the student's specific high school
- Have a certificate from the State of Texas naming this student the valedictorian of their specific high school
- Use the scholarship for any 2 of the first 4 regular semesters following the student's graduation from high school

Covers:

- Tuition and designated tuition only
- May be used for any 2 of the first 4 regular semesters following the student's graduation from high school
