

**Stanley F. Kelley, Ph.D.**, chairs the Department of Agricultural and Industrial Sciences at Sam Houston State University, where he teaches Animal Science. Dr. Kelley has hosted seminars on economical management practices for livestock, and maintains an active role in youth programs through out the state, contacting over 25,000 Texas youth annually to promote leadership development, personal responsibility, and the importance of education. He received SHSU's Excellence in Teaching Award in 1997, and was recognized by the SHSU Faculty Senate for outstanding leadership in academics in 2008.
