Purpose

Sam Houston State University (SHSU) is offering a 15-semester credit-hour certification program through the Department of Educational Leadership and Counseling.

The purpose of the program is to provide enhanced credentialing and training for academic advising professionals that have specific relevance to the field of academic advising.

Design

The Academic Advising Certification program is designed for the beginner or experienced

academic advisor, in both community colleges and higher education institutions. It is also designed for individual who have supervisory or leadership responsibilities for academic advising. All coursework is offered online and can be completed in 2 to 3 semesters.

Additionally, there is an option of enrolling in a one-semester internship, designed especially for individuals who have limited or no experience in academic advising.
