## **Eligibility Requirements**


- Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov)
- Be a U.S. Citizen or an eligible non-citizen
- Be regularly admitted to the Graduate Studies program pursuing a Masters Degree in an eligible program
- Be enrolled in coursework necessary to begin a career in teaching or plan to complete such coursework
- Must have scored above the 75th percentile on a college admissions test or maintain a 3.25 GPA
- Sign a TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve [www.teach-ats.ed.gov](http://www.teach-ats.ed.gov)
- Agree to teach full-time for 4 years in a high need area at Title I school after completing the program
