Traveling around the country for approximately 21 days, program participants will get to raft on a river, snorkel on a coral reef, sea kayak along one of the most beautiful coast in the world, meet with indigenous and tribal people, explore a tropical cave, visit beautiful Buddhist temples, ride an elephants, and even learn how to be a “mahout,” the person who cares for the elephant.
