

Good Neighbor Scholarship for Students from the Nations of the American Hemisphere

Scholarship Application Procedures

Application materials to submit to the Office of International Programs are as follows:

1. Two letters of recommendation by faculty or staff members (not your friends or relatives) who are able to speak to your academic achievements and/or contributions to the university and community
2. A copy of your transcript from previous semesters that show you maintained a satisfactory GPA (minimum 2.0)
3. A statement that describes your professional goals that you plan to accomplish when you return to your home country upon completion of your degree program

Eligibility of the scholarship:

You must meet the following criteria:

1. A non-immigrant resident from an eligible country (see the list of countries listed below)
2. Born in and currently a resident of a Western hemisphere nation other than Cuba or the United States
3. Intention to return to the eligible country upon completion of your degree program
4. Maintenance of satisfactory academic progress

Eligible Countries:

Argentina, Antigua and Barbuda, Bahamas, Barbados, Bolivia, Brazil, Belize (British Honduras), Canada, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Dominica, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, Grenada, Guatemala, Guyana, Haiti, Honduras, Jamaica, Mexico, Nicaragua, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, St. Kitts and Nevis, St. Lucia, St. Vincent and the Grenadines, Suriname, Trinidad and Tobago, Uruguay, and Venezuela
