

Introduction

The following data was compiled from both transfer and stdm files. The questions are listed above each table and a trend statement is listed below the question. In most cases, all the transfer students are used. However, in cases where schools are listed in a table, only schools who have greater than 30 total students over the 10 years were listed. Please refer to the notes after each question for more information. In general, the trend statements focuses on schools with large number of transfers.

Question 1) Total community college transfers for each of the last five years

Trend: Since Fall of 1992, the university has seen fairly consistent increases in transfer enrollment. While some dips can be found, it should be noted that these follow trends that can be found in both first-time beginning freshmen and total university enrollment. Also, the categories are yearly total, representing the Fall - Summer terms. The only inconsistency in this statement can be found in the final category, Fall 2001 - Spring 2002, for obvious reasons. However, this category is in line with the current upward trend in transfers to the university and could surpass previous highs.

Question 2) Total community college graduates for each of the last five years

Trend: Since Fall of 1992, the university has seen fairly consistent increases in transfer enrollment. This should and does transfer down to graduation, where the university has seen a consistent rise in transfer graduates. In fact, the number of students who graduated in Fall 2000 - Summer 2001 academic year is a 623% increase from The Fall 1992 - Summer 1993 term.

Question 3) Total transfers from each community college for each of the least five years. Is there a trend?
(NOTE SCHOOLS WITH LESS THAN 30 STUDENTS ENROLLED OVER THE 10 YEAR PERIOD WERE EXCLUDED)

Trend: The trend again follows the community college enrollment trends that were discussed in the earlier questions. What does bear some interest is the amount some college's transfers jumped in the Fall 1993 - Summer 1993 term, namely Blinn College (+1478%) Houston Community College (+721%) and North Harris/Montgomery (+827%). Blinn College is the one school who has provided a constant increase in students to the university. Also, Blinn College increased the number of transfers to Sam Houston, for the Fall 2001-Spring 2002 term, by 18% over the previous term, with that increase likely to rise with the final semester additions.

Trend: The trend again follows what we generally see in the total graduated population in that the majority of students graduate in Academic Studies, Criminal Justice, Business and Psychology. However, it is interesting to see how some schools contribute a significant amount to a certain major. For instance, 19.4% of all transfers who graduated with a major in Applied Arts-Science transferred from Angelina College. Also 31.8% of all transfers who graduated with a degree in Horticulture transferred from Wharton County Community College.
