



**Question 1: What is the total number of college transfers to the University for the period below?**

This chart shows the total number of students transferring to the University for the past six years. The percentage indicates how much of the total transfer population over this time period is made up by each year's total. There was an increase between Fall 2001 and Summer 2004. Most likely the increase will continue once the summer data for 2005 have been evaluated.

**Question 2: What is the total number of transfer students to graduate from Sam Houston over the last four years?**

Of the 10,788 transfer students who have entered Sam Houston Since Fall of 1999, less than 30% have graduated. Over 3,400 students had transferred to Sam Houston prior to the Fall of 2001, which could give them enough time to earn a four-year degree by Spring 2005. Those who entered not prior to but during Fall 2001 could also have been able to graduate, even without having any of their transfer credit hours. So, by the Spring of 2005 over 5000 transfer students could have graduated but less than 3,200 actually did.

**Question 3: During the past six years, what are the trends in the colleges that students choose to transfer from?**

The college sending the most transfers is North Harris/Montgomery Community College. This code includes all campuses in the North Harris Community College District. Next, with little more than half of this total, is Blinn College, followed by San Jacinto College. Montgomery and Blinn have both seen steady increase in the number of transfer students per year, while San Jacinto has remained steady. These trends do not include final totals for the current year as totals for Summer I and II are not yet available.

**Question 4: What are the total number of graduates who have transferred from other colleges?**

This data indicates the same trend as in Question three with one small difference. Blinn and Montgomery were still the largest groups of transfer students, but even though Montgomery sends more students, the amount of these students who graduate are slightly lower. Blinn had a total of 1735 students with 558 graduating meaning 32% completed a degree. Montgomery only saw 885 out of 3157 giving Montgomery 28% of transfer students who graduated.

**Question 5: What is the distribution, by major, for transfer students who graduated in the following years?**

The major with the largest number of transfer students who did graduate is Criminal Justice with 476. Second is Academic Studies with 421 students and then General Business with 347 students. These three categories alone make up 39% of all transfer students who graduated. Psychology was one of the largest gainers seeing an increase of 500%. General Business has also seen a quadrupling since 2000.

**Question 6: What is the distribution, by major, of graduates who have transferred from each of these Colleges/Universities**

This chart enables comparisons to be made between individual schools and what types of degrees students coming from these schools are likely to earn once at Sam Houston. Question four also looked at graduation rates but only divided it amongst years, not academic major. The totals for all graduates who came from each institution are the same totals as the graduates from the chart in question four. They each cover the same time period. Within the two groups that were by far the largest, transfer students from Blinn and Montgomery C.C., there were a few trends to be seen. Students from Blinn were most likely to earn a degree in Academic Studies followed by Criminal Justice and then General Business. Those three categories were also the top three groups by far for Montgomery C.C. students only General Business was number two and CJ was third.
