### Scholar in Residence

The Department of Mathematics and Statistics at Sam Houston State University seeks to hire a tenured or tenure-track Scholar in Residence. The candidate should be a recognized scholar and educator of mathematics, mathematics education, and/or statistics. The ability to enhance the scholarship and teaching of the members of the Department and an appreciation and respect for the Department and its role in the University are necessary. Also, the ability to provide recognition that would help with recruitment of students and faculty and procurement of outside funding is expected. An earned doctorate in mathematics, mathematics education, or statistics is required. Rank and salary are dependent on the candidate's credentials. Review of applicants will begin January 15, 2008 and continue until the position is filled.

Sam Houston State University is located in historic Huntsville 60 miles north of Houston in the Piney Woods region of East Texas. Sam Houston State University has a student enrollment of approximately 16,400 and a faculty of 650. The Mathematics and Statistics Department has 26 tenured faculty positions in mathematics, mathematics education, and statistics.
