Our Clinical program is designed to produce Master's-level practitioners who are qualified to sit for licensure as Psychological Associates by the Texas State Board of Examiners of Psychologists. With appropriate course work and work experience, graduates may also sit for licensure as Licensed Professional Counselors in Texas. The program provides 450 hours of supervised practicum experience and equips students with applied skills in psychometrics and professional intervention.

TRANSFER CREDITS

The University may accept up to 12 hours of course work completed at other accredited universities toward any of our Master's degrees.
