Unit 7.4 Functions of animal tissue

Instructions: Instructor will contact local butchers and meat sellers to acquire different animal organs such as sections of the stomach, intestines, bone, tongue, or external such as skin fragments, etc.

Set up on a table in a well-ventilated area to reduce the smell, or pack in ice and bring out one piece at a time, show and let the students see how different skin absorbs different liquids and prevents solids,

Take the tongues and show the taste buds and where the esophagus begins, and how the food is passed through the body.

Materials: Organs/tissue, Coolers, Clean shop table, Ice, Knife, Water,
