

### Degree Planning Sheet for BS in Agribusiness (AGBU): 2018 – 2022 Catalogs

Consult with an Agribusiness academic advisor before changing the sequence of courses. Failure to complete courses in the recommended sequence may delay graduation. For best results, earn an A in each course!

<sup>1</sup> If a student is interested in attending graduate school in Agribusiness or Agricultural Economics, it is highly recommended to take MATH 2399 in addition to MATH 1324.

<sup>2</sup> When students take MATH 1324, it may also count as their Component Area 2 (CA2) course if not already taken. ECON 2301 may also count as CA8.

<sup>3</sup> UNIV 1101 or 1301 may be substituted if required by university admissions or if the student is enrolled in the Ag Cohort.

<sup>4</sup> Students should consult with an Agribusiness advisor to determine if there is a specific natural science for their minor. ANSC and PLSC minors must take CHEM 1406. CHEM 1407 is recommended for the second CA3.

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
