COBA LEADERSHIP TEAM MINUTES

Wednesday, November 14, 2018

- 1. Approval of Minutes. The minutes were modified and approved.
- 2. <u>Curriculum Review.</u> At the previous Leadership Team Meeting, the Dean asked the Chairs to ask their faculty if the college should create an Intro to Business Course since it is part of the new Field of Study for Business. The Chairs said their faculty did not want to create an Intro to Business course, but would use an elective in their programs to allow the course to transfer in from another college. The Leadership Team decided to create a faculty committee to look at the BANA 2372 and BANA 3363 courses since Statistics is now included in the Field of Study. The Dean will draft a charge to the faculty committee. The Dean would like to have a master syllabi created by the end of March. The Leadership Team had a discussion on if a third economics course should be required in business core. The Dean wants to ensure that there is a thoughtful process before making a final decision.

3. CAD update.

- a. Revised FES related policies. A CAD committee presented a new draft of the FES policy during CAD. The Chair of the Faculty Senate will take it back to their group. They had concerns about the section on congeniality.
- b. Emeritus Status. When a faculty member retires, the faculty can make a recommendation on Emeritus Status to the Dean through the Chair. Then the Dean can make a recommendation to the Provost. Recommendations for Emeritus Status will no longer have to be reviewed by a university-wide faculty committee.
- c. President's Cabinet/CAD meeting. There is a President's Cabinet/CAD meeting scheduled for January. Each Dean has been asked to provide a summary of the duties of their associate deans and staff in their college. Another issue that will be addressed is financial efficiencies.
