Financial Aid

Dual-enrolled STC Students. If you are dually enrolled at STC and want to take SHSU courses, see the information below about your financial aid.

For students attending STC and SHSU, the HOME school will be where the student is degree seeking and taking the most credit hours. There is a shared TEAMs channel so that the two Financial Aid Office can communicate and assist students with the consortium agreement process.

SHSU's tuition/fee payment is due at 10:00 pm the night before the semester starts. We do offer [payment plan](#) and [emergency loan](#) options to allow time for the refunds to be issued from STC and payment to be received at SHSU. If the student is at STC, they can visit the Financial Aid Office there for assistance with the consortium agreement and if the student is here in Huntsville, then they can visit SHSU Financial Aid Office for assistance.

Online 15- or 5-week Courses

If you do not see what you are looking for or you want to combine online and in person courses, CJ and Victim Studies courses are available in 15- or 5-week formats, while Homeland Security courses are in 5-week only. You could take one in person course and one online course each A, B, and C term and never have more than two courses at the same time, earning 12 semester hours.
