Courses

Once students have been admitted to SHSU, they will find the courses above available for registration. To register for these courses, the student will need to complete an advising appointment or contact Lori Rodriguez or Hannah Mongeau at CJAcademics@shsu.edu in the CJ department to have the course restriction lifted. This course restriction prevents students from unintentionally registering for courses in Brownsville.

Financial Aid

Dual-enrolled TSC Students. If you are dually enrolled at TSC and want to take SHSU courses, see the information below about your financial aid.

For students attending TSC and SHSU, the HOME school will be where the student is degree seeking and taking the most credit hours. There is a shared TEAMS channel so that the two Financial Aid Office can communicate and assist students with the consortium agreement process.

SHSU's tuition/fee payment is due at 10:00 pm the night before the semester starts. We do offer [payment plan](#) and [emergency loan](#) options to allow time for the refunds to be issued from TSC and payment to be received at SHSU. If the student is at TSC, they can visit the Financial Aid Office there for assistance with the consortium agreement and if the student is here in Huntsville, then they can visit SHSU Financial Aid Office for assistance.

Parking Permits
