Early Childhood Literacy and Mathematics Plan Yearly Target Goals

In accordance with Texas Education Code §11.185, Sam Houston State University Charter School establishes annual targets to improve early literacy and mathematics outcomes for students. These targets focus on Grade 3 STAAR performance while student progress is monitored in earlier grades to ensure strong foundational literacy and mathematics skills.

Literacy Target Goals (STAAR Reading)

Sam Houston State University Charter School will increase the percentage of Grade 3 students who meet grade level or above as measured by the STAAR Reading assessment.

Mathematics Target Goals (STAAR Mathematics)

Sam Houston State University Charter School will increase the percentage of Grade 3 students who meet grade level or above as measured by the STAAR Mathematics assessment.

2029 85%

Monitoring Student Progress

Although annual targets focus on Grade 3 outcomes, Sam Houston State University Charter School monitors literacy and mathematics development beginning in the early grades. Student progress is reviewed through multiple measures including mCLASS reading assessments, classroom formative assessments, benchmark assessments, and STAAR results in Grades 3–6. Instructional teams review student data regularly to support continuous improvement in literacy and mathematics instruction and ensure students are developing strong foundational skills.



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
