Parents: websites, apps, directly from students and teachers Nonparents: friend or family, local news and TV, social media - Texans highly favor increasing state funding for public schools 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - How was the question for time off worded? - What the average stipend for mentor teacher? Angie answered SHSU is seeing ranges from \$500-\$3500.
<p>TEA Residencies & Strategic Staffing</p> <p>Mrs. Angie Taylor</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Teacher residency increased by 139% between 21-22 and 23-24; this was helped by grants - TEA took feedback on enhanced residency certificate process - TEA is now accepting EPP applications for the enhanced residency: SHSU Epp has applied, if approved we will start Fall '25 - Enhanced residency host teacher requirements: 3 years of experience, accomplished educator with proficient or higher ratings on teacher evaluations, demonstrated evidence of positive impact on student learning, trained by an EPP, and has a valid certification for the assigned area - TEA Data on stipend amounts for mentor teachers and teacher candidates 	

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - More grant opportunities coming out next year <p>Clinical teaching at SHSU</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 76% of students are being paid in their yearlong clinical placement. THANK YOU DISTRICTS! <p>Spring SHIPS Feedback – March 2024</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - “Would like more support for students to pass exams” → new role of Diane Clark at SHSU - “Professionalism” → Addressed in orientation - “Need to have a variety of teaching placements and experiences” → over summer, SHSU evaluated coursework and field experiences <p>District Personnel Survey- Sent out in May 2024</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Next time, one email will go to CT and one to the district admins to distribute to principals - Voices of cooperating teachers’ data: we will use this data as SHSU decides on what to cover during CT’s training - Voices of Principals 	
<p>Considerations to Review</p> <p>Angie Taylor</p>	<p>-TEA ID Numbers: What is best way for us to get this information:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Adobe Sign? Half of the room like this idea; another suggestion was to enter in immediately in the spreadsheet that is sent out with initial placements. It was decided that either option will suffice. <p>-TAC 228 Changes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 50 hours pre-clinical hours required; pathways are getting more than enough required. Secondary students do not have as much time to get these hours, so they need to get all in one semester. Zero districts posed a concern for this requirement. - New Terminology: same program, new terms (listed in PPT) <p>-Requests to graduate “non-cert” to start paid position sooner</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Please partner with us to help encourage SHSU students to finish out their program and not delay for short term benefits

Bill to fund residency, \$22,000 would be extremely beneficial for districts. Maybe we can work together with EPP to promote this to legislators</p>
