If House Bill 2 passes, could potentially mean: no uncertified teachers in foundation areas (no DOI teachers), pay incentives for different certification levels, shift of things from SBEC control to commissioner’s, provides more ways to put certified teachers in the classroom - Dr. Edmonson will be at the capital on March 6th and April 1st – if there are any concerns you have from a K-12 level, please let us know - Texas Teacher Residency program: SHSU is approved to offer the new certificate for students that go through pathway – will earn an Enhanced Residency Certificate. - Apprenticeship Program: under the Department of Labor, federal money to use in Educator Preparation - Streamline AAT pathways: working with programs across greater Houston area for transfer programs through community colleges universities - Induction ceremony: event for students newly admitted to the SHSU EPP to celebrate and honor the profession of being an educator - Educate Texas: policy group is supporting a teacher pipeline luncheon to present our EPP program on February 28th

<p>Considerations to Review Angie Taylor</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Over 70% of students in their clinical teaching are being paid during their experience, almost \$2.5 million given to YCT students during 24-25 - SHSU Communication Guide: listed in our <i>Guidelines for Clinical Teaching</i>; we are reminding our coordinators of the procedures to follow - TAC Reminders: pre-clinical students need 50 hours rather than just 30 hours - Reminder of TAC language - Need for more classroom management training: SHSU has moved a course earlier in the program to provide training sooner, we have also moved clinical teacher training earlier
