## **INFORMATION & GUIDELINES PERTAINING TO WALK ONLY REQUESTS**

# COLLEGE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SAM HOUSTON STATE UNIVERSITY

This document lists guidelines pertaining to Walk Only Requests for the College of Criminal Justice. Please review the information below *before* completing the Permission to Participate in Commencement Ceremony – Walk Only Request Form.

Please note, if the request is approved, participation in the commencement ceremony **does not signify completion or conferral of degree** - the degree will be conferred in the semester in which **all** requirements are met. A new graduation application must be submitted for the term in which degree completion is expected.

#### **Guidelines:**

#### Circumstances

- Students must have <u>emergency or extenuating circumstances</u> that would prevent them from participating in the
  ceremony during the term when degree requirements are fulfilled. Such circumstances may include a death or
  terminal illness in the immediate family, military service obligations, relocation, etc.
- It is important to note that certain circumstances, such as preference or convenience of a specific ceremony date **will not** be taken into consideration.

# **Progress towards degree requirements**

## Undergraduate

Students should be able to complete remaining degree requirements within one academic semester.

#### Graduate

• Students must have successfully completed their Thesis/Dissertation Prospectus Defense.

### **Academic Standing and GPA**

- Students should be in Good Academic Standing (not an Academic Standing of Suspension or Termination) and should have a GPA above 2.0 for Undergraduate and 3.0 for Graduate level students.
- Students may be considered if they are slightly GPA deficient AND it is our belief that the GPA deficiency can be overcome with remaining credits in a timely manner.

- 3. Graduation Application & fee to the Registrar's office
