

Biography for LTC Joshua Limberg

Lieutenant Colonel Joshua Limberg is a native of Kent, Washington. He enlisted in the Army in July of 1995 as an Infantryman and attended Basic Training in Fort Benning, Georgia. After five years of service in both the Infantry and Military Intelligence and earning the rank of Sergeant he was awarded a four-year Green to Gold scholarship. He commissioned in August 2004 into the Infantry and eventually branch transferred to Military Intelligence.

Lieutenant Colonel Limberg has served in a variety of leadership and staff positions. He was a Counterintelligence/Human Intelligence Platoon Leader with the 502d Military Intelligence Battalion out of Joint Base Lewis McChord, Washington. He has 32 months of company command time where he commanded Bravo Co 109th MI BN and Headquarters and Headquarters Company 109th Military Intelligence Battalion. He was stationed at Pearl Harbor Hickam, Hawaii where he served as the Korea Branch Chief and Watch Officer for the Northeast Asia Division of Indo-Pacific Command's Joint Intelligence Operation Center. He was also stationed in Fort Meade, Maryland where he served in the 902d Military Intelligence Group where he was a Battalion Operation Officer and Executive Officer for 308th Military Intelligence Battalion. His last duty assignment was with 1st Capabilities Integration Group (Airborne) where he served as the senior Counterintelligence Officer. He is currently serving as Professor of Military Science for Sam Houston State University.

Lieutenant Colonel Limberg's education includes a Master of Science in Strategic Intelligence from the National Intelligence University where he focused his studies on cyber warfare and Signals Intelligence. He has also attended the Counterintelligence Course and the Signals Intelligence warfare Course. He has graduated the Command and General Staff Course, University Senior Leader's Course, Common Faculty Development – Instructor Course, Military Intelligence Captain Career Course, the Military Intelligence Officer Transition Course, and the Infantry Officer Basic Course.
