ELIGIBILITY

The Carson Thomas Miller Texas Emerging Composers Competition is open to any student who will be enrolled in a Texas high school during the Fall 2021 semester.

GUIDELINES

Solo/chamber works (up to 8 players) for any combination of instruments and/or voice (including electronic and electro-acoustic works) will be considered. Works for large ensembles will not be considered. Each composer may submit only one composition (multi-movement works allowed).
