Vacation: Residents will receive 3 weeks of vacation per academic year. No more than 2 weeks may be taken at a time.
Pediatric Emergency Medicine Experience: This experience will occur longitudinally during the three 4-week blocks of Emergency Department rotations. The OakBend Medical Center Emergency Department census has a 12% pediatric population annually. Residents will exceed the required 75 emergency department patient encounters with children based on the Emergency Department volume.
