



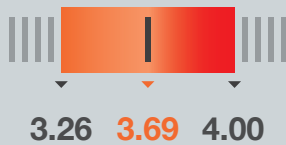

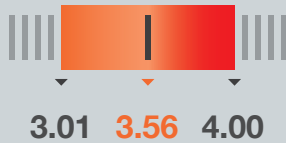

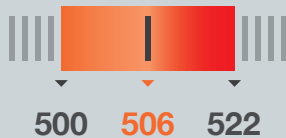
#### AVERAGE UNDERGRAD GPA
