#### \*Important Information regarding scholarships:

- Students must have a 2.75 GPA to be eligible for all scholarships.
- Scholarships are disbursed one month before the student travels.
- Students could be eligible for additional funds to support their study abroad trip; please get in touch with your college for that information.

\*The Global Engagement Center offers merit-based scholarships to assist qualifying students to cover some of the expenses of studying abroad. Each year, we give out around \$100,000 in scholarships. The funds are limited, and scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis. We highly recommend that students apply early after they have submitted their study abroad application.
