☐ **Activate Your SHSU Email** (Required before Orientation)

Activate your SHSU email and computer account through [SamWeb](#). After acceptance, your SHSU email is the only email used by SHSU offices. Activation is required to access different portals and register for Bearkat Orientation.

☐ **Check Your Texas Success Initiative (TSI) Status** (Required before Orientation)

Check your TSI status by reviewing [DegreeWorks](#) (TSI section). If you are missing scores (or an exemption) for any component (Math, Reading, and/or Writing), "Testing Required" will be posted in that component. If you are not TSI exempt, or if you are missing a score for any component, you will need to schedule a TSIA2 exam; this can be completed either in person or online with the SHSU Testing Center. Please note this must be completed before you attend Orientation.

☐ **Submit Bacterial Meningitis Documentation** (Required before Orientation)

Meningitis A documentation is required before selecting on-campus housing and registering for classes. Documentation must be submitted online to the KatHealth Patient Portal before you select your dorm room or attend your Orientation session.

☐ **Submit Housing Application & Deposit** (Required before Orientation)

First-year students who have recently completed high school (within one year) are required to apply for housing, live on campus, and purchase a university meal plan.

☐ **Submit Official College Transcripts** (Required before Orientation)

Submit transcripts of all coursework completed before attending SHSU (dual credit/college coursework or AP/CLEP scores) to the Admissions Office after you have received final course grades. All transcripts must be official and from the college awarding credit. This must be done before academic advising at Orientation to ensure you create an accurate course schedule with your advisor.

☐ **Check for Registration Readiness** (Required before Orientation)

☐ **Schedule Academic Advising** (Required before Orientation)

All incoming students are encouraged to schedule a 1-on-1 advising appointment prior to attending Orientation. This can be done from the SAM Center website and will give you the option to select an in-person or virtual appointment. If you are unable to complete this prior to your Orientation session, you will be able to attend a group advising session at that time.

☐ **Register for Bearkat Orientation** (Required before Orientation)

Register for Freshman Orientation through your personalized invitation. You will receive an invitation to register for Orientation when registration opens, but only if you have activated your SHSU email through SamWeb. You will meet with your Academic Advisor and register for classes at your Orientation session.
