If student transfers to SHSU core complete, no additional coursework is required. Consult Advisor for best course options.
- (2) Major Prescribed Electives: Select 26 hours from options listed [here](#). 9 hours must be 3000 or 4000 level (Advanced), from the Prescribed Electives. \*HLTH 3380 from LSC will not count as advanced credits, but will apply towards major prescribed electives
- (3) BIOL 2401 and BIOL 2402 may be used as transfer courses for the requirement of BIOL 2403 and BIOL 2404.
- (4) MATH 1342 may be used as transfer courses for the requirement of MATH 1370.

### Program Specific Information:

#### **Bachelor of Science in Public Health**

- Student must earn a 2.75 minimum overall GPA in all coursework.
- 42 semester hours of advanced coursework (3000 or 4000 level) are the absolute minimum. Minimum number of semester hours in residence: 30 semester hours of which 24 must be advanced.

  - will be eligible for additional scholarships
  - may develop their LSC Honors thesis (if completed) into an SHSU Honors thesis (and thereby graduate "with Highest Honors")
  - will be eligible, if space permits, to live in SHSU's dorms
