# Program Specific Information:

## Bachelor of Business Administration in General Business Administration

- Students must earn a 2.0 minimum overall GPA in all coursework.
- 42 semester hours of advanced coursework (3000 or 4000 level) are the absolute minimum. Minimum number of semester hours in residence: 30 semester hours of which 24 must be advanced.

  - o will be eligible for additional scholarships
  - o may develop their transfer Honors thesis (if completed) into an SHSU Honors thesis (and thereby graduate "with Highest Honors")
  - o will be eligible, if space permits, to live in SHSU's dorms
