## **Program Specific Information:**

#### **Bachelor of Business Administration in Management**

- Students must earn a 2.0 minimum overall GPA in all coursework.
- A minimum grade of "C" is required in all Management (MGMT) courses taken for the Management major.
- 42 semester hours of advanced coursework (3000 or 4000 level) are the absolute minimum. Minimum number of semester hours in residence: 30 semester hours of which 24 must be advanced.

  - o will be eligible, if space permits, to live in SHSU's dorms
