If students take SPCH 1321, they will need 3 additional hours of any general elective to reach 120 total hours. If students take EDUC 1300, they will need 3 hrs in Core 090 - Component Area Option.

(3) Advanced Business Electives include any course with a/an ACCT, BANA, BUAD, ECON, FINC, MGIS, MGMT, MKTG, or REAL prefix (3000- or 4000- level, not BUAD 3301).
