Scholarship Overview: This small scholarship is designed to assist students with the costs of preparing for law school. Such costs include an LSAT prep course, paying to register for the LSAT, costs of law-school application fees, and other related costs. The scholarship committee will consider GPA, extra-curricular activities, participation in LEAP Center activities, membership in the Pre-Law Society, and enrollment in an LSAT Prep course, as well as other factors that relate to a students' potential for attending law school. The scholarship will consist of a single award of between \$100 and \$300.
