Scholarship Overview: This small scholarship is designed to assist students with the costs of preparing for law school. Such costs include an LSAT prep course, paying to register for the LSAT, paying for LSAC's Credential Assembly Service for law school applications, costs of law-school application fees, and other related costs. The scholarship committee will consider GPA, extra-curricular activities, participation in LEAP Center activities, membership in the Pre-Law Society, and enrollment in an LSAT Prep course (or other costs related to law-school applications), as well as other factors that relate to a student's potential for attending law school. The scholarship will consist of a single award of between \$200 and \$1,300. Please note that the scholarship committee may request additional information or documentation.

Deadline: The deadline for the 2020 scholarships is **April 10 at 5:00 pm**. Awards will be announced on a rolling basis and the awards are limited to available funds.
