



Partners Resource Network is a non-profit agency that operates the Texas statewide network of Training and Information Centers (PTIs) funded by the U.S. Department of Education-Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP). The four PTI Projects: PACT, PATH, PEN, and TEAM serve parents of children and youth with disabilities from the ages of 0 to 26 as well as youth self-advocates ages 14-26. We do this through a network of highlyskilled, regionally-located coordinators. Regional Coordinators are knowledgeable in local policies, services and resources as well as state and national level guidelines. Services are provided in English and Spanish.
