SHSU Employer Survey

TITLE OF ASSESSMENT: SHSU Employer Survey

PROGRAM: All advanced programs

PURPOSE OF THE ASSESSMENT: To assess the degree to which employers are satisfied with advanced completers' preparation.

ADMINISTRATION: Each June, the survey is sent to employers of advanced completers who are employed in a position for which they were prepared in the previous academic year.

HOW THE DATA ARE ANALYZED AND INTERPRETED: The survey was administered in 2018-, 2019, and 2020. However, the completion rate was low, necessitating compiling the three cycles of data. 151 respondents participated in total, and responses by program are available in Data Table 1.

The first section of the survey is common among all employers of advanced completers. Respondents are asked to respond to questions about completers' job performance and areas of strength and improvement for the EPP.

Completers' employers then answer questions regarding the degree to which they were satisfied with the completer's specific preparation program. Each question is aligned to at least one of the program's SPA standards using a 1-3 Likert scale. Average responses are then calculated and reported in tables 3-7 below.
