## 1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish the criteria necessary for students to qualify to graduate with honors from SHSU.

## 2. CRITERIA

- 2.01 To qualify to graduate with the recognition of Cum Laude, Magna Cum Laude, or Summa Cum Laude students must:
  - a. Have attained a minimum grade point average of 3.50 computed on all SHSU courses.
  - b. Have achieved not less than a 3.50 cumulative grade point average computed on all accepted transfer courses and SHSU courses.
  - c. Have completed not fewer than thirty semester credit hours in residence at Sam Houston State University; not fewer than twenty-four of these hours must be advanced.
  - d. Have completed all other requirements for graduation at SHSU.
- 2.02 The distinction and corresponding grade point averages are:
  - a *Cum Laude* both the SHSU grade point average and the cumulative grade point average must be 3.50 to 3.66.
  - b. *Magna Cum Laude* both the SHSU grade point average and the cumulative grade point average must be 3.67 to 3.85.
  - c. *Summa Cum Laude* both the SHSU grade point average and the cumulative grade point average must be 3.86 to 4.00.
