Following the timeline from my Nov. 29 email, I am pleased to share drafts of the four revised academic policies for your review. I've included two versions of each draft below: one with the "Track Changes" feature turned on to show how the working group edited the current policy into the proposed draft, as well as a clean draft of the proposed updated policy without markups.

In addition to the policy drafts, the academic policy review work group has provided a <u>supplementary document</u> that outlines four broad goals that led their efforts based on earlier faculty feedback, as well as the substantive changes made to each policy.

Next Steps

Between March 11 and April 3, the academic review policy work group will convene to review feedback and determine what, if any, changes are necessary. The final drafts are due to me by April 4, at which point I will initiate the standard process for policy review. The process will be completed by May 4, the last day of the spring semester classes.
