The Director of PACE, [the Professional and Academic Center of Excellence](#), is now accepting applications for the Associate Director of Development, one of two half-time faculty positions created in 2019 to support the current SACS-COC Quality Enhancement Program (QEP), [Engaging Classrooms](#). From 2019-2024, the QEP will improve student learning and student success outcomes through an increase in the use of active learning techniques in classrooms across campus. Through a carefully designed sequence of faculty development programming; travel & teaching grants; classroom redesign; and the use of Faculty Learning Communities, Engaging Classrooms has the potential to impact the learning experience of each of our students.

It is the responsibility of the ADD to develop programming for Engaging Classrooms, to recruit faculty members for each component, and to ensure that all faculty training and enrichment initiatives operate fully and smoothly. In addition, the ADD regularly coordinates with both the PACE Director and the Associate Director for Assessment.

Interested faculty may submit a letter of intent and a CV to tprimm@shsu.edu before December 1, 2020. Letters of intent should detail experience with the position responsibilities, previous participation in faculty development, and reasons for interest in serving as ADD. Faculty interested in the position can discuss details with either the current PACE Director Todd Primm or the current ADD Brandy Doleshal. Following review of the letters of intent, selected candidates will be invited for interviews for the position. Once interviewed, applicants will need to receive approval for the appointment by their Department Chair and College Dean.
