B. New Business

- Executive Order SP 25-01
- 2 Vote In's
 - President Scott opened the floor for any COCJ Senators interested in switching to a different college caucus.
 - Senator Menefee questioned whether she would still be able to attend COCJ meetings if she switched.
 - Madame Vice President confirmed she could, but would also be required to attend her new caucus meetings, based on her declared minor.
 - Senator Mogekwu reached out to current COCJ Senators to encourage them to consider switching.
 - Senator Menefee asked if switching back to COCJ would be possible next year.
 - o President Scott confirmed that it would be allowed.
 - Senator Menefee officially stated she would switch over to the CHSS Caucus.
 - Senator Cantu raised a concern about switching next year, noting that her affiliation with COCJ is already listed on the election ballot.
